(Questions and Scripture for further study)

1. Last week we looked at the dream Moses had for the Israelites and how God replaced that dream with an even more powerful one. To continue the story of Moses, read Numbers 20:2-12; 27:12-23 and Deuteronomy 34. Write out a time line of the events. Why was Moses denied entrance into the Promised Land? How do think he felt when God told him the consequence of his striking the rock? What was his outward response to God's decision? Read Matthew 17:1-3 and Hebrews 11:24-28. What is the legacy of Moses?
2. The life of Moses did not go according to the plan Moses had. What are the dreams most of us have in common? How do we usually respond when things don't go as planned? Can you share a time when a changed plan was better than the original? Do you have a plan that has gone wrong and you are still wondering how it might get better? How do you feel about it and what is your outward response?
3. Read John 21:15-17. Peter had given up everything to follow Jesus and then Jesus was arrested, Peter denied knowledge of Him and Jesus was crucified and buried. In what way did Jesus change the dream of Peter? Read Acts 2:14 and 40-41. How did God use Peter?
4. Spend a few minutes asking God to reveal how He might want to use you in ways you have not considered. Listen to His response and consider how you need to respond.
